ALK participates in the Royal delegation, as we believe that it will strengthen our and our partner's relationship to representatives from Japanese Ministry of Health, Labour and Welfare and increase local awareness of our allergy treatment offerings.

An estimated 25-35 million people suffer from allergy caused by Japanese cedar tree pollen or house dust mites. Cryos International is the world's largest sperm bank and has been supplying donor sperm - and now also donor eggs - to more than 100 countries worldwide throughout the past 30 years.

About 10-20% of all heterosexual couples worldwide are suffering from unwilling childlessness. About 50% of these couples due to male infertility, and therapeutically solutions are very limited, however, for most people a sperm donor is the solution.

Furthermore, there is an increasing number of lesbian couples and single women who have focused on their career and postponed reproduction. Due to this we see a significant increase in the demand for sperm donors in the recent years. We see the same pattern in developed countries all over the world.

Japan has one of the world's lowest birth rates (1.46) which slowly induces a burden of elderly which will have a significant negative impact on the economic growth during the coming 50 years.

We understand that there is no legislation governing the services of donor sperm and donor eggs in Japan, neither regarding donation/treatment nor regarding parental rights.

In Denmark, there has been a fertility friendly policy throughout more than 30 years. During this period, the birth rate has increased from 1.38 in 1983 to 1.79 in 2016 where 10% of all new born are a result of Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART). The highest ART birth rate in the world!

The purpose for participating in the Royal Visit event is to meet and exchange views and experiences with experts in ART and lawmakers in Japan with the aim of introducing a modern sperm and egg bank program in Japan.
